The slight premium in storage fees applicable to non-NSRCC members is inevitable as we need to factor in the membership due that is normally a pre-requisite in the industry. This will apply immediately for new-comers but for existing clients, it will only kick in from 1 January 2010 to create a more equitable balance in line with the membership privileges accorded to NSRCC members.

## **SAILING DURING THE NORTH-EAST MONSOON**

After a good season of South-Westerly winds, many sailors are accustomed to the side-shore wind condition and the easy take-off and return during such conditions. The coming North-East Monsoon condition will prove more challenging, especially to those who have a problem with sailing close-hauled as that's the only way to sail back to shore during such conditions. Do take heed of the following:

- a. Take extra care and sail with a buddy or at least inform someone on shore to keep a lookout for you and let our shore crew know the time you're expected to return to shore.
- b. Be extra careful during incoming tide as the wind-over-tide condition will take you westward and you're likely to end up at National Sailing Centre or beyond if you get lulled into sailing free and face a double-whammy effect of losing ground downwind and drifting westward.

Above all, ensure that you give your equipment a complete inspection for reliability and assurance that it will withstand the more extreme conditions during the North-East Monsoon. Tighten up your skeg, foot- straps and replace all worn-out parts or lines. Ensure that your mast is not worn out or chafed at the points where it is constantly in contact with your cams or boom end. Also check the rivets on your boom ends to ensure that they are not coming apart.
